How does Project ECHO[®] work?

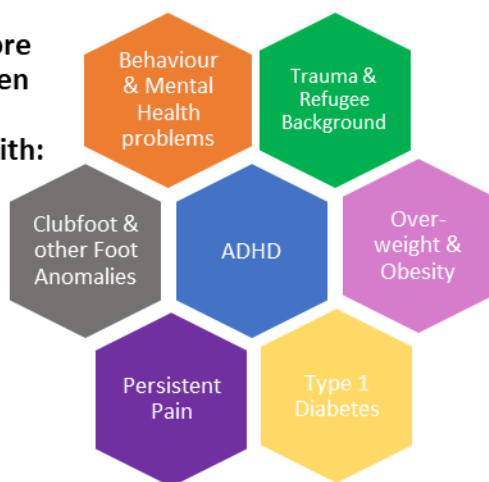
Through an on-line **virtual learning network**, ECHO[®] builds on the capacity of local providers, **using case-based learning**:
